Bail

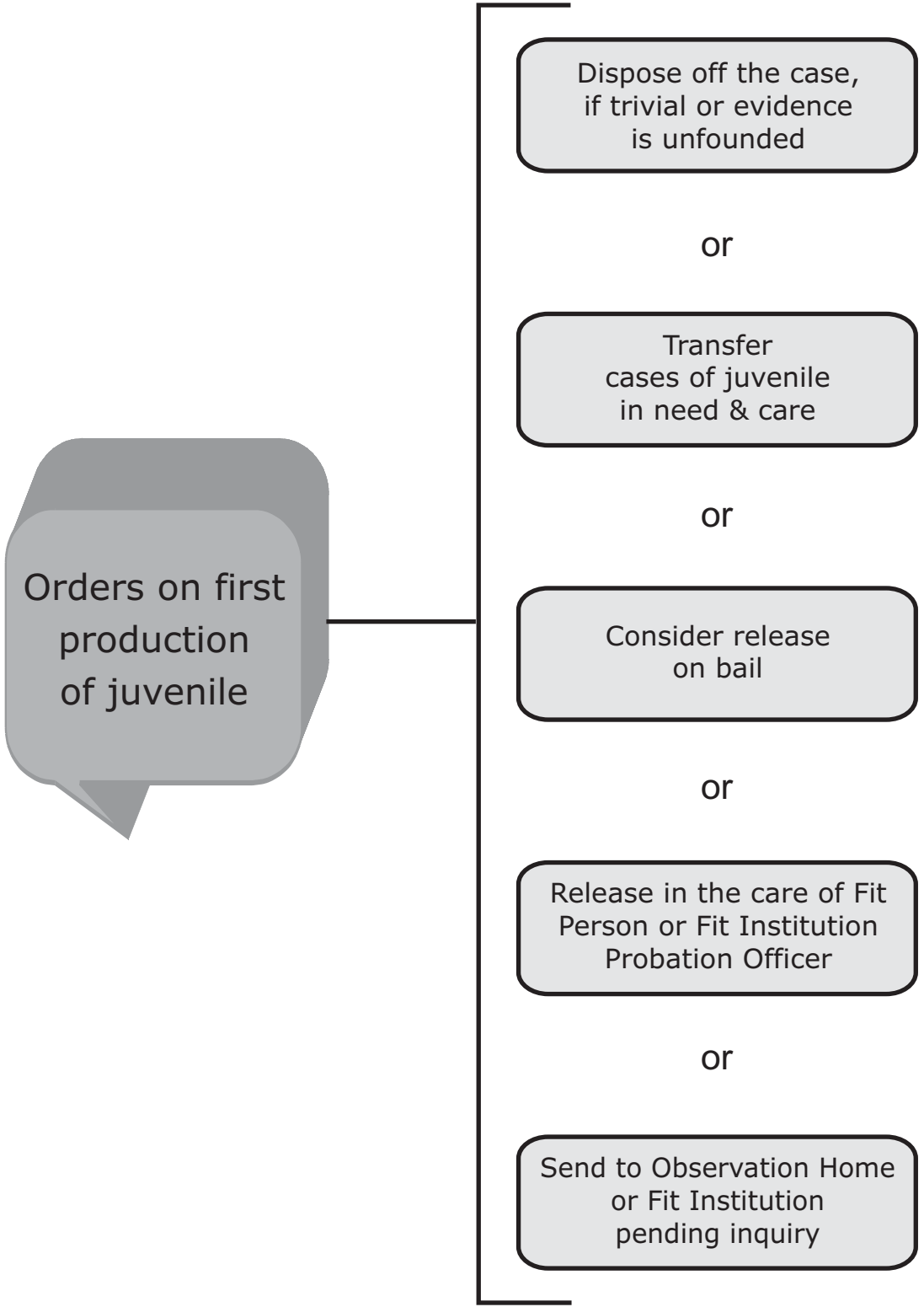
If apparently a Juvenile, Board to consider bail

Release is likely to bring him in association with any known criminal

Release is likely to expose him to moral, physical or psychological danger

Release would defeat the ends of justice

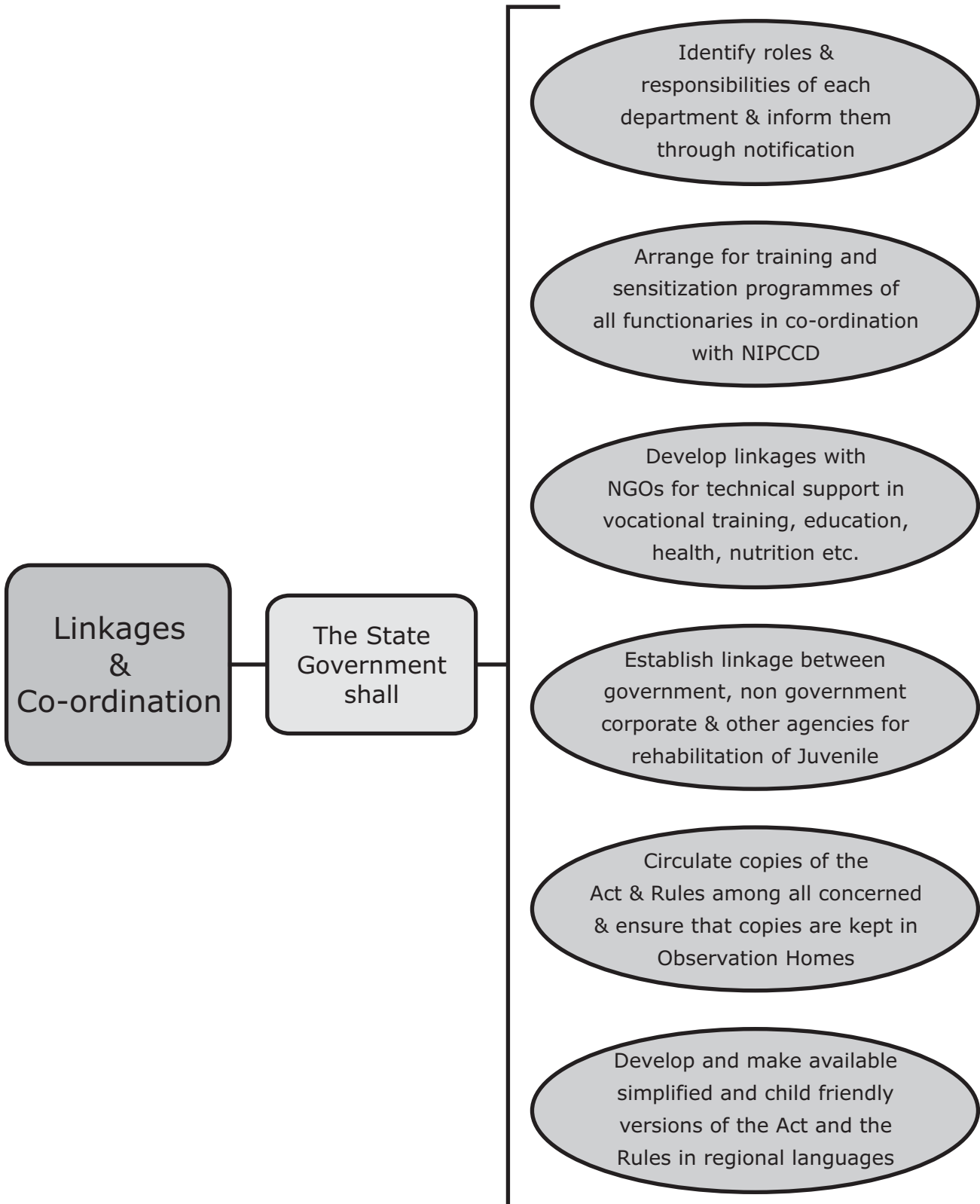
Child Protection Unit (CPU)

Functions of State CPU

- Implementation of the Act
- Supervision of agencies and institutions
- Provide funds to District CPU
- Co-ordinate with all government departments on child protection issues
- Train government and non government personnel
- Establish minimum standards of care in all institution and ensure their implementation

Functions of District CPU

- Implement family based non-institutional services including sponsorship, foster care, adoption etc.
- Ensure setting up of Child Protection Committees
- Facilitate transfer of children for restoration
- Co-ordinate with all Government Departments on child protection issues
- Train Government and Non Government personnel
- Organize quarterly meetings with all stakeholders



Juvenile Justice Fund

Assets of the Fund include contributions from:

Central Government

State Government

Statutory & Non-statutory bodies set up by Central or State Government

Voluntary donations from any individual or organization

The fund shall be administered by State Advisory Board

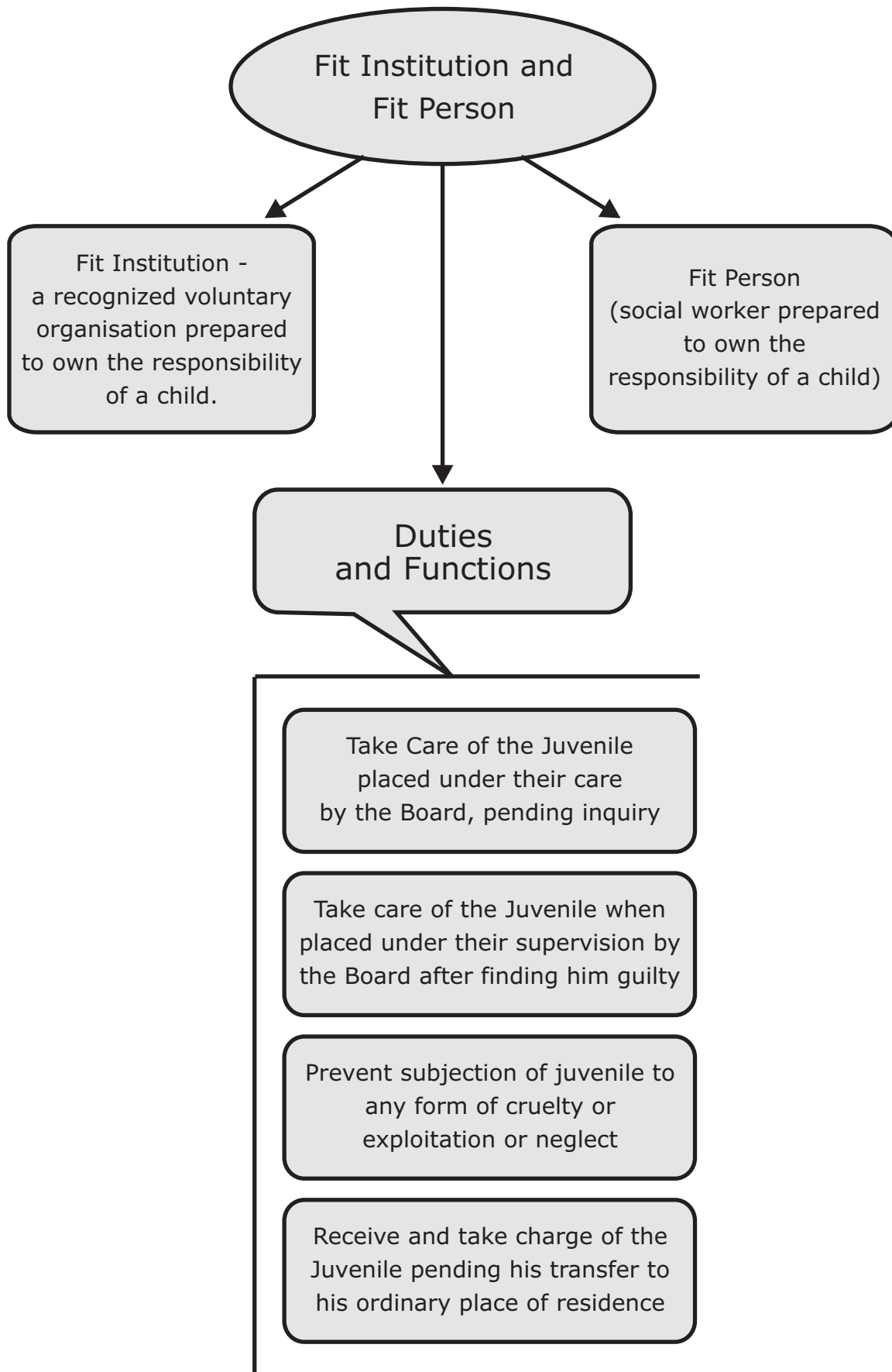

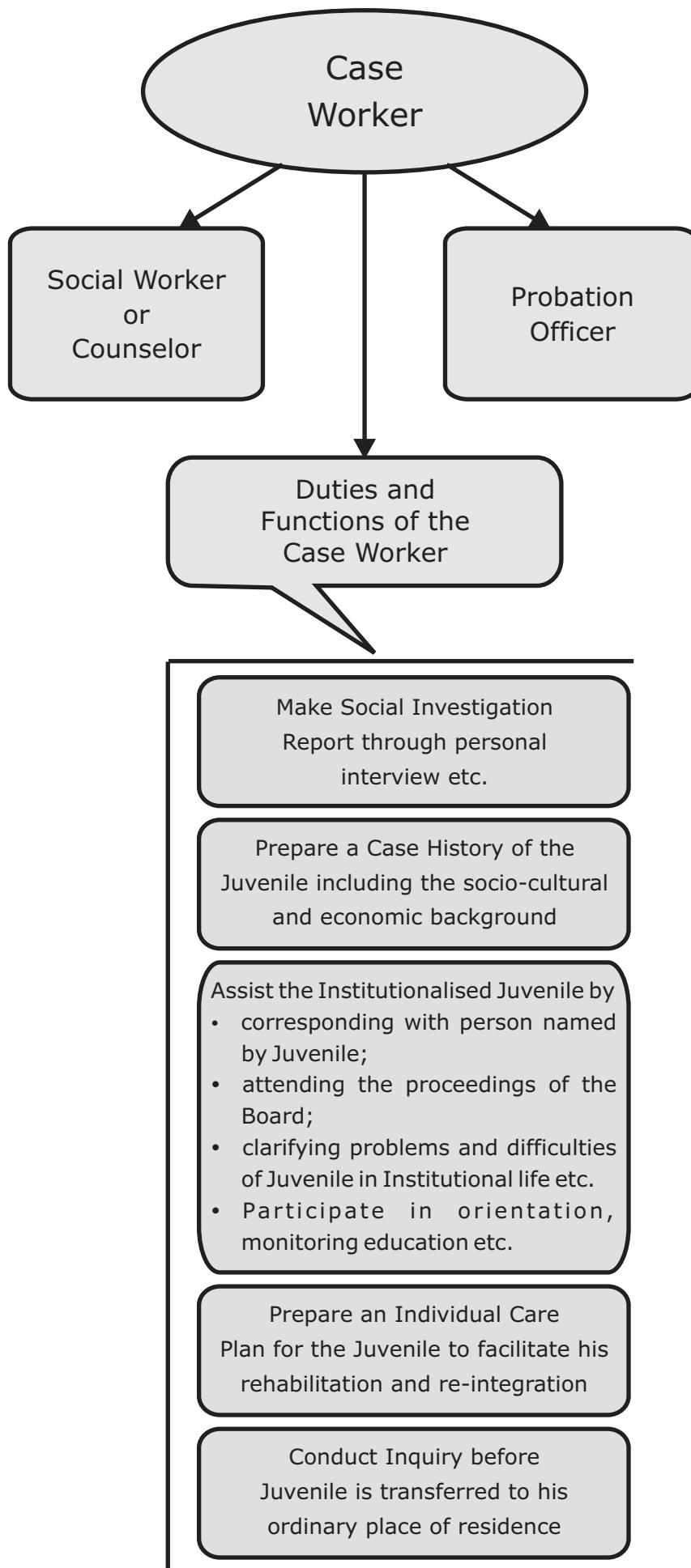
After Care Programme

The programme is to be prepared by the District or State Child Protection Units in collaboration with Voluntary Organizations

The NGOs may function as the After-care Organisation for rehabilitation and social reintegration of juveniles after they leave special homes

Key Components of the Programme

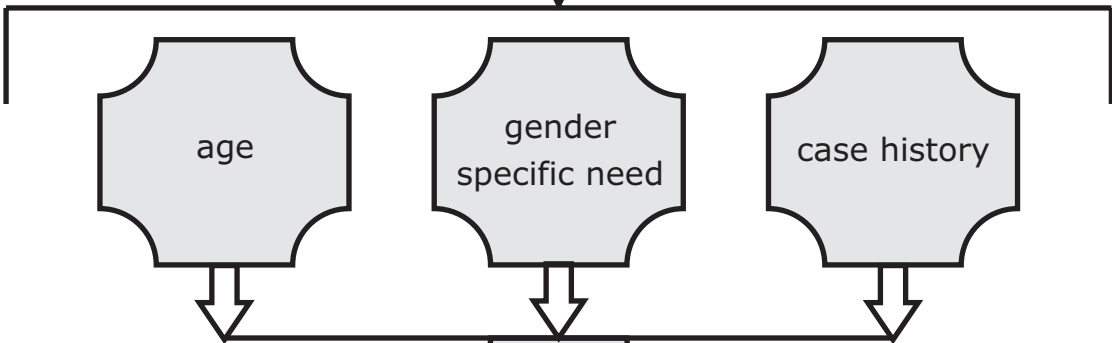
- Community group housing on a temporary basis
- Encouragement to learn a vocation or gain employment
- Encouragement to gradually sustain themselves
- Provision for a peer counsellor
- Arranging loans for entrepreneurial activities



Legal
Aid

- The Board shall ensure free legal service to all juveniles
- The legal officer in Child Protection Unit/Legal Service Authority shall extend free legal service to all juveniles
- The officer-in-charge shall co-ordinate with legal officer of Child Protection Unit/Legal Service Authority to ensure that every juvenile is legally represented
- Board may seek legal service from recognised voluntary legal service organisation or university legal services clinics
- The Board may deploy the services of student legal service volunteers & NGO volunteers for para-legal tasks
